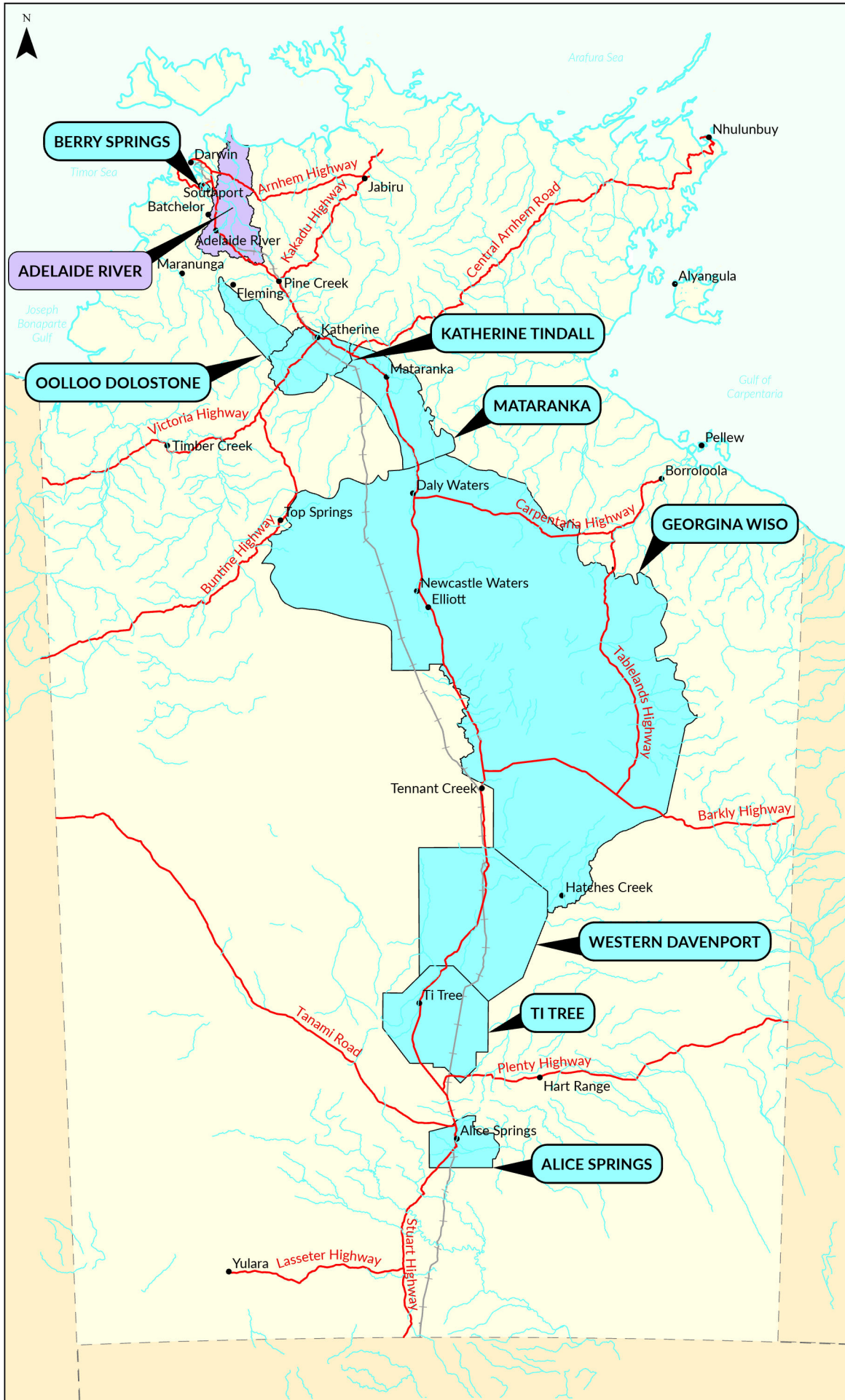


NT WATER ALLOCATION PLANNING AREAS



Water Allocation Plans aim to ensure the equitable sharing of available water between users to protect the environment and ensure the long term sustainability of the water resource. They usually occur in regions where there are competing demands for water. There is a risk from water use to significant environmental values or a need to manage the whole system (surface water and groundwater resources) due to their significant inter-connection.
